Though most of us can barely even imagine what it's like to live in these conditions, this is what thousands live like every day in Guatemala. Our partners there, Food for the Poor, work very hard to make sure all that we send gets into the hands of these families.

Poverty is tied in with the country's uneven income distribution and land ownership. It is highly concentrated in 7 out of 10 people in the indigenous communities. Guatemala has the highest rates of malnutrition in the Western hemisphere - with children, as always, being the hardest hit.

We thank the Lord for His provision! We were able to ship **5** overseas containers of supplies to Guatemala in October!
